Zvonka T Simčič je ena redkih vizualnih umetnic, ki v svojih delih pristopajo k temi materinstva na izrazito angažiran način. (Ne)možnost umetne oploditve samskih žensk je problematizirala v nadvse inovativnem performansu *Doulas »ad utero, ab ovo«* (2007), kjer je ob podobi sebe kot noseče Device Marije predstavila lastno izkušnjo oploditve, nosečnosti in rojstva otroka. Odločitev za umetno oploditev predstavlja v državi, kjer tovrstna pravica samskim ženskam ni omogočena, pogumno in drzno dejanje suverene posameznice, ki s takšno gesto hkrati zavrača žensko podrejanje moški hegemoniji pri reprodukciji.

Po rojstvu sina Adama je v *Newih alegorijah* (2008, 2009) obravnavala poporodno obdobje in vlogo matere samohranilke ter odnos države do enostarševskih družin. V najnovejšem videou z naslovom *Tiha moč* (2012) avtorica dalje razvija predhodno izpostavljene vsebine in hkrati z aktualiziranim motivom Lepe Vide slovenski družbi sporoča, da se ne strinja z diskriminatornim izidom referendumu o Družinskem zakoniku, na katerem so bile zavrnjene pravice otrok iz vseh svobodnejših oblik družin. V državi, kjer pravice manjšin niso nikomur mar, Zvonka T Simčič na aktivistično-umetniški način v svojih delih na ogled postavlja lastnega otroka. Sama se v položaju prekerne delavke, ki se kot svobodna umetnica v vlogi matere samohranilke sooča s številnimi eksistencialnimi težavami, predstavlja v podobi Lepe Vide, ko z vso težo odgovornosti po obronku nosi svojega otroka v svet.

Zvonka T Simčič se za pravice žensk in otrok pogumno bori skupaj s soborkami z različnih področij umetnosti. V fotografiski realizaciji jo z umetniškimi fotografijami že vrsto let podpira Nada Žgank. Kantavtorica Ksenija Jus se ji v glasbeni spremljavi tokrat pridružuje s svojo aktualno verzijo tragične Lepe Vide, ki postane žrtev kapitalističnih kriminalcev. Z uporniškimi besedili jo v ženskem pevskem zboru Kombinat tovariško podpirajo tudi dekleta, ki s kolektivno močjo skupine glasno prepevajo revolucionarne pesmi upora z vsega sveta in verjamejo v solidarnost, srčnost, pogum ter socialno pravičnost.

Lepa Vida Zvonke T Simčič ni za pravičnejši svet radikalno žrtvovala ne svojega, ne sinovega življenja. Po obronku ju ne peha v pogubljenje, temveč ju z voljo, v kateri sta združena hrepenenje in boj, rešuje pred brezihodno situacijo. Ni se pesimistično vdala v usodo, temveč se aktivno, borbeno in hrabro upira dani situaciji. Avtorica se s svojimi umetniškimi deli bori na edinstven način, ko kot umetnica in mati, odeta v podobo Lepe Vide, stopa z otrokom v naročju po travniku hrepenenja pravičnejšemu in boljšemu svetu naproti.

Zvonka T Simčič is one of the few female visual artists whose works address the theme of motherhood in an extremely engaged manner. In her innovative performance *Doulas "ad utero, ab ovo"* (2007) she critically addressed the problem of the (non-)possibility of single women being artificially inseminated, such that by means of the image of herself as the pregnant Virgin Mary she presented her own experience of insemination, pregnancy, and birth. The decision to be artificially inseminated represents, in a country where such right is not ensured to single women, a courageous and bold act of an autonomous woman, who has also rejected the subordination of women to the male hegemony with regard to reproduction.

Following the birth of her son Adam, in *New Allegories* (2008, 2009) Zvonka T Simčič addressed the role of a single mother, and the treatment of single-parent families by the state. In her latest video, entitled *Silent Power*, 2012, she further develops her topics and by means of the motif of Fair Vida communicates to Slovene society that she disagrees with the discriminatory outcome of the referendum on the Family Code, by which rights were denied to children from more liberal family forms. In a country where nobody cares about the rights of a minority, Simčič exposes her own child to the audience in an activist-artistic manner. Having the position of a precarious worker and freelance artist, Simčič encounters numerous existential problems in her role as a single mother; she presents herself through the image of Fair Vida while carrying her child along the edge of a hill into the world – and assumes the full weight of responsibility.

Zvonka T Simčič courageously fights for the rights of women. For a number of years now her efforts have been backed by the artistic photographs of Nada Žgank. And for the purposes of the present performance she has been joined by the singer-songwriter Ksenija Jus, with her topical version of the tragic Fair Vida, who becomes a victim of capitalist criminals. Furthermore, she also enjoys the comradeship and support of the women in the female choir Kombinat, who by means of the collective power of a group sing out revolutionary songs of rebellion and believe in solidarity, sincerity, courage, and social justice.

Simčič's Fair Vida did not radically sacrifice either her own life or that of her son for a world more just. The author is not pushing her characters along the edge of a hill into ruin, but is rather saving them from a dead-end situation by means of a will that combines a certain yearning and struggle. By means of her artworks Simčič fights in a very unique way when, as an artist and mother impersonating Fair Vida, she walks, with her child in her arms, through the meadow of yearning towards a more just and better world.
